#### Profound Multiple Learning Disability Mobile App

Health Education Thames Valley and Health Education Wessex have recently produced the Profound Multiple Learning Disability (PMLD) mobile app for use on android, apple and blackberry devices. This app has

been developed to support everyone, professionals and carers, to help people with profound and multiple learning disabilities live a fulfilling happy and healthy life. It contains top tips and references to access further information on how to care for people who need high levels of support from others with most aspects of daily living.



#### My Little Fairy

This was developed by Plexus Games. There is no dialogue in the app, but this is intentional, since all of the characters are fairies. Instead of speaking, the fairies communicate with each other through facial expressions and sound effects. The world they

inhabit is in 3D and the illustrations are gorgeous. The fairies and scenery come together to create a free play environment to explore. The simple music and twinkling sound effects add to the app creating an overall experience for players to enjoy. Visit http://www.plexusgames.com/mylittlefairy/.



## Cause and Effect

What happens when the jar is shaken or turned upside down?

Make sure the lid is screwed on tightly - or what happens if it is not!



## Sticky Art

This is such a simple activity! You will need:

- A roll of sticky clear plastic usually used for covering books or surfaces. Place the clear plastic on a clean floor, with the sticky side upwards.
- · Tape the edges so it does not slip.
- Shoes off, see what it feels like to walk on the sticky surface, listen to the noises.....



Now turn the sticky plastic into an abstract collage by providing a range of different collage materials such as tissue papers, sequins, beads, feathers,

pasta. A great group piece of art!




